Music For Nikhil[®]

The Nikhil Badlani Foundation, Inc. was formed to honor the memory of Nikhil Badlani, an 11-year-old West Orange student tragically lost in an automobile accident. Nikhil had a gift and a passion for music, and one of The Nikhil Badlani Foundation's mission is to sponsor music lessons to deserving West Orange students. The Music for Nikhil[®] Program (the "Program") was launched in January 2012. We are now offering lessons to the students for academic year 2018-19.

Lessons are offered in band, orchestra instruments and voice. Semi-private lessons will be provided to students who demonstrate talent, commitment and passion for music. The lessons will take place after school hours at the school. Days and times will be determined based on the availability of the instructors. There will be a culminating performance by the participants at the end of the school year.

Students must apply to be admitted to the Program. Only Students that can commit their participation in the Program for the entire academic year of 2018-19 should apply. Seats in the Program are limited. All things being equal, preference will be given to early applicants. Admission to the Program is at the sole discretion of The Nikhil Badlani Foundation based on the criteria listed below.

The selection process will give preference to students who meet as many of the following criteria as possible:

- The student has demonstrated an aptitude for music.
- The student should have played the instrument of choice for at least one year and is a member of the school band/orchestra group.
- The student is a responsible young person who will be committed to the Program for at least one year.
- The student has demonstrated a good work ethic in the classroom.
- The student must demonstrate the need for financial aid, to receive full scholarship.

In addition, **all new applicants** are required to write a one-paragraph essay describing why they should be considered and how would they benefit from the Program. Students that are returning to the Program do not need to write the essay. The Nikhil Badlani Foundation's review board may consult the school music faculty for feedback in helping determine acceptance to the Program. After review of the application, the student may also be required to audition. Students accepted into the Program are required to attend the orientation with a parent.

The form must be submitted by Friday, August 30, 2018, to the music teacher or mailed to 22 Florence Place, West Orange, NJ 07052. Parents/Guardians will be contacted if their student is accepted.

PROGRAM POLICIES

Absence Policy

As a member of the Program, you are expected to attend the lesson each week. Given that the lessons are conducted in a group, it is important that you attend, practice and keep up with your group. Attendance will be taken at every lesson. If you are unable to attend a particular lesson, please provide an oral or written notice to the Program latest by 9AM on the date of the lesson. **If two or more lessons are missed with no explanation, a parent/guardian will be contacted. If three or more lessons are missed with no explanation, you will be removed from the Program.** Lessons missed by the teacher will be made up at the earliest possible date. However, there will be no make-ups or refunds for student absences.

Program Fee

The weekly hour-long lessons will be provided at no cost to need-based students and at a cost of \$17 – 50 per session plus any material costs, for other students. This cost is based on the number of students in a lesson, with a maximum of three students in a group. The Program Fees must be paid in full for the term, prior to the start of the first lesson. You may make the payment at the Meet & Greet session. Students may not start the program without full payment of fees. Please make checks payable to the Nikhil Badlani Foundation. The Program Fees above do not include additional costs for supplies, books, instrumental repairs etc. that may be associated with lesson (herein “Additional Fees”). The student will be responsible for any Additional Fees.

Financial Assistance

The program offers financial assistance and strongly encourages those with financial need to apply. Students interested in applying for financial assistance should fill out the Financial Assistance Form (herein the “Form”). The Form can be obtained from the school music teacher or by emailing sangeeta@nikhilbadlanifoundation.org. Please return the Form in a sealed envelope to the school music teacher or mail to Nikhil Badlani Foundation at 22 Florence Place, West Orange, NJ 07052.

Refund Policy

In the event that lessons are cancelled and not rescheduled, a refund will be issued at the end of each term. A student is eligible for a full refund before the first lesson and a prorated tuition refund after the first lesson, in the event that they need to withdraw from the Program. No tuition refunds will be issued if the student decides to withdraw from the Program after the second lesson, except for medical reasons. If there is a medical reason, the student must provide a doctor’s note and will receive a prorated tuition refund.

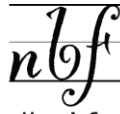
